Sample Midterm

These are sample questions that are very similar to the ones I will ask on the midterm.

- 1. Which of the following Python identifiers are legal variable names? For those that are not, say why not.
 - (a) x
 - (b) Celsius
 - (c) spam3
 - (d) <hello>
 - (e) question?
- 2. What is the data type (int, float, string, boolean) of the following? Please evaluate them.
 - (a) 3.9 + 6
 - (b) 5 + 1 > 7 or 2 == 1 + 1
 - (c) int("3")
 - (d) 7 / 2
 - (e) 8 // 3
- 3. Write the following formulas in Python.
 - (a) a^2
 - (b) $\frac{x}{y+z}$
 - (c) $12x \frac{3}{y}$
- 4. What does the following program print?

```
for i in range(1, 5):
    x = (-1) ** i * i
    print(i, x)
```

5. Convert the following into a "for" loop.

```
i = 1
while i <= 10:
    print(i)
    i += 3</pre>
```

6. When I ran the following program:

```
x = int(input("Enter a number: "))
y = 1 / x
print("The reciprocal of", x, "is", y)
```

I got the following error message:

```
Traceback (most recent call last):
   File "x.py", line 2, in <module>
      y = 1 / x
ZeroDivisionError: int division or modulo by zero
```

What was the specific error? Where did it cause the exception? And what did the user type?
